

Still Using No. 6 Oil?

DEP Regulations are phasing out No. 6 Oil by June 2015. If you are still using No. 6, it is important that you act today.



DEP Boiler Regulations and Enforcement

No. 6 oil permits will NOT be renewed (last permits expire June 30th, 2015)

- Running a system on an expired permit will result in a **Notice of Violation** and **fines**.
- You will be called into a **Cease and Desist Hearing** if your system continues to run on No. 6 after the Notice of Violation.
- Further noncompliance may lead to boiler shut down.

Now is the time to plan

- Planning may take a number of months. The winter heating season is the perfect time to start so that you can finish your conversion project ahead of the deadline.
- Spring will be a busy time for the contractors, plumbers, and engineers that you may need to hire to finish your conversion. It is important to secure contracts as soon as possible.
- DEP enforcement measures will have a negative effect on the credit standing and insurance risk of your building.

Boiler Filing Guideline

☐ Fuel Oil Conversions

- Conversion from #6 fuel oil to cleaner fuel - #4, #2, or Natural Gas (**DEP will not renew any Certificate of Operations for #6 Fuel Oil**)
 - Submit an Amendment for the Fuel Conversion (Can be online by PROFESSIONAL USERS only from the link <https://a826-web01.nyc.gov/DEP.Permits.Requests/CatsRequestPreparationClient/>) or submit a copy of the LAA filed with NYC DOB by mail to DEP.
 - When the conversion work is completed, submit an affidavit (notarized) of work completion. This can also be done online <https://a826-web01.nyc.gov/DEP.Permits.Requests/CatsRequestPreparationClient/>.
 - For expired Certificate of Operation, please follow the steps below:
Boiler Certificate of Operation – Renewal, Amendment & Affidavits – Online CATS Permitting System (DEP will not renew Boilers firing fuel oil #6)
 - You must have a valid e-mail address (user name) and register with DEP.
 - You can either use the below link to create an account with DEP:
